CLEANING HARDWOOD FLOORS

After talking with over a thousand people that are unhappy with the way their hardwood floors look, I have found the # 1 thing they are doing that causes problems comes from buying products for hardwood floors. Most of these products build up or dull the beauty of the floor and can't be removed. Below is my recommendation..

- 1. Clean floor with vacuum cleaner or soft broom to pick up as much loose dirt or dust as possible.
- 2. Because the broom or vacuum cleaner will not remove the dust, spray a light mist of Orange Lustre on the bottom of a good dust mop and dust the floor. If you use too much Orange Lustre it will make your floor slippery, so start in the non traffic areas and then work over toward the traffic areas. The excess Orange Lustre will dry if you stay off the floor. Excess Orange Lustre can be removed with a damp mop. (Micro-Fiber mops work really well and are the only mop I use and recommend.) I have surveyed hundreds of people that own the Micro Fiber mops and 99% always say they love their mop!!!.
- 3. If there are some spots that remain after dusting with Orange Lustre, clean the spot, not the entire floor. Usually you will find these spots were made from products containing sugar; like juice, soda and etc. Only water dissolves sugar. I recommend putting water or our diluted Orange Pow'r All Purpose cleaner (2 capfuls to a quart of water) on the spot and let it set for a minute to soften the spot and then wipe off with a cloth or mop. Remember to never use a wet mop on hardwood floors. Orange Pow'r does an excellent job when you want to do a damp mopping on your hardwood floor. Most of the time your hardwood floors are only in need of dusting. Some traffic areas may require a more frequent cleaning, however, less cleaning is best.

NOTE: For hardwood floors in the kitchen, especially around the stove area, you can use more of the Orange Lustre to clean the areas where grease and grime from cooking has settled. **Caution:** Be sure to go back and remove the excess Orange Lustre because it will make the floor very slippery. I recommend using a Micro-Fiber mop sprayed with a light mist of our diluted Orange Pow'r All Purpose cleaner (use 2 capfuls of Orange Pow'r to 1 quart of water in a spray bottle) and mop one more time. This is to remove any excess Orange Lustre that could make your floors very slippery. You can use the diluted Orange Pow'r on hardwood floors with a good finish with a lightly dampened mop, but never a wet mop. We have customers that love using the Orange Pow'r on their floors. It is great for vinyl and tile floors also.

If the finish on your hardwood floor has worn off or it never had a finish to begin with, just use more Orange Lustre on your dust mop.
